Thank you to all of the AADA members who participated in SkinPAC's first Convention Challenge! Your support helped SkinPAC raise \$68,042 from July 18-28! These funds will help SkinPAC continue its work election pro-dermatology candidates! As promised, the state recognition results are as follows:

Most Dollars Raised:

1. Texas - \$8,176 **WINNER**
2. New York - \$8,155
3. Georgia - \$7,800

Most New Contributors:

1. Florida – 10 **WINNER**
2. Georgia and Pennsylvania - 3

Highest Average Dollars Contributed:

1. Arizona - \$3,250 **WINNER**
2. Arkansas - \$2,500
3. Illinois - \$1,100

Highest Participation Rate:

1. New Hampshire – 4.23% **WINNER**
2. Mississippi – 2.59%
3. Georgia - 2.56%

All AADA members have the right to refuse to contribute without reprisal. Federal law prohibits us from accepting contributions from foreign nationals. Federal law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, physical address, occupation, and the name of the employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 in a calendar year.
